B23.3.1 At the time of judging no person shall be allowed in the judging ring save the judge, the properly appointed steward or stewards, the exhibitor or his deputy, with each dog, or other persons authorised by the Chief Steward.

Rationale:
The term Administration Officer dates back in time. Today's Association is view as and run as a business. This amendment will allowing Governing Council to appoint a contemporary working name to the position.

Recommendation of Governing Council 26 May 2021
To amend Clause 5 of the Constitution
From:
 - 28.8.5 Upon the conclusion of the Committee's investigation, the Committee will make a recommendation to the Administrative Officer, which may include but is not limited to, referring the complaint to **any board or tribunal** established by the Governing Council for the hearing and determination of disputes and complaints, or that no further action is required.
 - 29.1 The Governing Council, **Committee, Tribunal or Board**, whichever shall apply, may at any time, after giving notice to the parties before it, take whatever action it deems necessary to achieve a fair and just conclusion of any matter before it and to that end without restricting the right of the Governing Council, **Committee, Tribunal or Board**, it may adjourn any proceedings to a date to be fixed, call witnesses or seek opinion upon any matter as it sees fit
 - 29.3 The respondent / defendant must be in attendance of any hearing of any matter, complaint or dispute, unless otherwise ordered by the Governing Council, **Committee, Board or Tribunal** (whichever apply). Non-attendance will be treated as a matter of contempt of the Governing Council.
 - 30.1 Any Member or Affiliate involved as respondent or complainant in a case charged with an offence, subsequently penalised and who is dissatisfied with the decision and/or penalty of a **Committee, Tribunal or Board**, or who is generally dissatisfied with a decision of a **Committee, Tribunal or Board** against that Member or Affiliate, will have the right of appeal to a **Committee or Board** established by the Governing Council for the hearing of appeals.



- 30.2 Should the Association be dissatisfied with the decision and/or penalty of a **Committee, Tribunal or Board**, it shall also have the right to appeal to a **Committee or Board** established by the Governing Council for the hearing of appeals against the decision and/or penalty.
- 30.3 No Council Member appointed to the **Committee, Tribunal or Board** who participates in a hearing which is the subject of an appeal to the Governing Council shall participate in any debate or have any vote on the appeal before the Governing Council.

To read:

- 28.8.5 Upon the conclusion of the Committee's investigation, the Committee will make a recommendation to the Administrative Officer, which may include but is not limited to, referring the complaint to any Committee established by the Governing Council for the hearing and determination of disputes and complaints, or that no further action is required.
- 29.1 The Governing Council or Committee whichever shall apply, may at any time, after giving notice to the parties before it, take whatever action it deems necessary to achieve a fair and just conclusion of any matter before it and to that end without restricting the right of the Governing Council, or Committee it may adjourn any proceedings to a date to be fixed, call witnesses or seek opinion upon any matter as it sees fit.
- 29.3 The respondent / defendant must be in attendance of any hearing to determine any matter, complaint or dispute, unless otherwise ordered by the Governing Council or Committee. Non-attendance will be treated as a matter of contempt of the Governing Council.
- 30.1 Any Member or Affiliate charged with an offence and subsequently penalised and who is dissatisfied with the decision and/or penalty of a Committee will have the right of appeal to a Committee established by the Governing Council for the hearing of appeals.
- 30.2 Should the Association be dissatisfied with the decision and/or penalty of a Committee, it shall also have the right to appeal to a Committee established by the Governing Council for the hearing of appeals against the decision and/or penalty.
- 30.3 No Council Member appointed to the Committee who participates in a hearing which is the subject of an appeal to the Governing Council shall participate in any debate or have any vote on the appeal before the Governing Council.

Rationale : The Constitution defines a Committee as - any Committee, Tribunal, Board and/or Working Party established by the Governing Council to fulfil specific tasks, including governance functions as prescribed in Section 19.1.4.

These sections of the Constitution currently use the word Committee as well as the words Tribunal and or Board, but not consistently. The use of these words is unnecessary as the word Committee, by its definition includes them. Also in section 30.1 the Constitution should not contain struck through words, this appears to have been a formatting issue in the draft. The Complaint in a case that has Proceeded to Hearing is the Association and it's right of appeal are specified in section 30.2

11.3 Moved: A Rushby

THAT the review and rewording of the Association's Rules and Regulations be completed and approved by the Governing Council by no later than 30 June 2022 to take effect from 1 July 2022.

Rationale:

Following 2007 Annual general Meeting it was resolved by Governing Council to review the whole of the rules and regulations with the aim to make the wording simpler to understand, eliminate repetition and ensure relevant items were in the same sections.

The review of the whole of the rules and regulations of the Associations commenced some twelve years ago. To date, this review has yet to have the draft submitted to our solicitor to review and advise amendments required prior to adoption by the Governing Council.

There have been a number of changes in both councillors and staff over these years which has attributed to the delay in the completion. The Stop Puppy Farming legislation actions have also taken up a lot of time which have been warranted.

12. GENERAL BUSINESS

Please note:

Constitution 35.4 The Annual Financial report of the Association shall be made available to the Members, for collection from the Association's office, at least ten (10) working days prior to the date set for the Annual General Meeting. If Members wish to receive a researched answer, they are to submit to the Administrative Officer any queries for discussion five (5) working days prior to the Annual General Meeting.

Amended Dogs West Regulations

- **THAT** CAWA Regulations Section A be amended by the addition of new regulation:

A1.3 The terms CAWA and Dogs West shall each mean the Canine Association of WA (Inc) trading as Dogs West.

- **THAT** CAWA Regulations Section A Be amended to read:

4.1 All parts of the Dogs West Regulations, Rules and Codes are to be read in conjunction with the ANKC Regulations, *Rules and Codes. Dogs West Regulations, Rules and Codes take precedence, unless silent on the matter, then ANKC Regulations, Rules and Codes will apply.*

Note: ANKC documents are available from the Dogs West office or the ANKC website.

- **THAT** CAWA Regulations Section H Be amended to read:

2.22 A member shall not permit any of that members' ANKC Pure Bred Registered dogs, without prior approval from the Association, to be used in any mating which would result in a litter being ineligible for registration on the ANKC Register. This includes

- 2.22.1 To a dog of a different breed
- 2.22.2 To a cross bred dog
- 2.22.3 to a non ANKC registered dog of the same breed or

2.22.4 to a dog not on the ANKC Main Register

2.22.5 a mating not in compliance with R2.1. **02/21**

RETRIEVING TRIALS IN 2021

It was so good to be able to have our competitions back, albeit with some minor adjustments for Covid.

Novice & Restricted stakes.

The April 18th at Morangup by the RCWA, with a fantastic entry of dogs, Kerry Webster put the novice dogs through their paces over various terrain, and into water, with some pleasing results. 1st place E Shepherd and Hazel. (Lanlwyd Maree (Imp UK) - 168 points, 2nd place - I Molyneux Ollie (Bodhran Miss Daisy) on 164 points, 3rd place - G Joyce with, Watson (Cinderset Black Onyx) with 150 points.

Restricted stake was judged by Allan Bartram. A double mark, blind and two bird, and walkup doublerise was set for these competitors, with quite a jump in skills needed to achieve a great result.

1st Place - and gaining their NRD title - I Molyneux and Ollie, with 163 points, 2nd place - T Little and Sam (Brigodee Diamonds Boy) with 139 points, 3rd Place - T Merceica and Hannah (Korskote Treasure Trove) with 78 points.

The next planned event for April 24th, was cancelled due to covid restrictions and lockdown, so the next event was May 2nd with the RCWA at Beverley.

Judge was Heather Ellis and this site afforded loads of cover, gullies, and obstacles for the dogs to attack. Novice 1st place E Shepherd with Hazel on 175 points, 2nd place A Nesbitt and Dora, (Demore All The Rave) with 171 points, 3rd place - A Deasy with Roux (Ellishea Wyatts Le Roux), on 160 points.

Restricted began with a doublerise, then mark and blind, and lastly a mark/two bird. 1st place - I Molyneux with Ollie on 156 points, 2nd place - E Shepherd and Hazel on 139 points, and 3rd place A Deasy and Roux, on 129 points.

ALLAGE STAKES

Saturday April 3rd the RCWA had their Peter Reekie trial, with judge Richard Courtman. 1st place - Phoenix (RT Ch Ellishea Just Cussy CM) with 172 points, owned by H Ellis, 2nd place -dog Flash (RT Ch Ellishea Wyatts Flash), also owned by H Ellis, 171 points. 3rd place Eva, (RT Ch Boormagic All Saints Eve) and Colin Hankinson on 160 points.

The following day the Labrador Club held the Marie Ewen Trial, with nine dogs entered. Judge Eleanor Johnson, and again some challenging triple retrieves were set for the dogs. 1st place on 159 points was H Ellis and Phoenix (RT Ch Ellishea Just Cussy CM), 2nd place on 127 points K Webster and Tux (Brigodee Diamonds Bow Ty N Tux), and 3rd place Mark Jackson and Ozzie (Ozzie of Aberdeen) with 126 points.

Next scheduled event for April 25th (Anzac Day) was cancelled due to a Covid lockdown, so our next trial was held on May 8th by the ANRTWP at Jennacubbine.

Judge Ray Johnson began his trial at this new site, with a triple walkup marks, then a double mark and blind on the second, and a blind doublerise and mark for his third.

1st place Tux (Brigodee Diamonds Bow Ty N Tux) with 155 points run by K Webster. Second place went to Phoenix (Ellishea Just Cussy) and H Ellis on 148 points, and 3rd place to Heather's Flash (Ellishea Wyatts Flash) with 138 points. The following day the ANRTWP's second All Age trial, judged by Allan Bartram. With the first run a mark, doublerise and two bird. Next was a double blind and a remote mark which the dog saw from the hide only. The last run, was a Mark, doublefall and blind, and four of the five dogs completed these retrieves to finish the trial. Presentations of places had in first place with 152 points, and a big cheer from the gallery, Kerry Webster's Tux, who can now be proclaimed a Retrieving Trial Champion, having won both AA trials this weekend. Great work and congratulations. Second place on 145 points was Flash, owned by Heather Ellis, and in third place on 141 points, Phoenix, owned by Heather.

As always, we appreciate the people who come to our trials to work out in the field or gun steward. Many thanks to all who travel, and put into our sport so willingly.

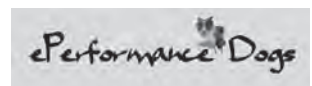

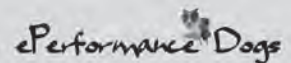

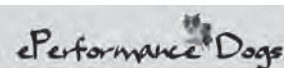

Code of Ethics MEMBERS' CODE OF ETHICS (latest amendment February 2021)

SECTION H - CODES OF ETHICS

HM MEMBERS' CODE OF ETHICS (effective 1 March 2008)

HM1 ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Each person, when signing an application for membership or renewal of membership of the Canine Association of Western Australia agrees to the following:

- to be bound by the ANKC Ltd regulations and rules
- to be bound by the Constitution, Rules and Regulations of the Association
- to be bound by the Association's Code of Ethics
- To allow the inspection of the member's premises as required for the purpose of investigating compliance with the regulations and the code of ethics. 04/17

HM2 CODE OF CONDUCT

- 2.1 A member shall not knowingly or recklessly misrepresent the ANKC or the member's Member Body.
- 2.2 A member shall not engage in any behaviour that is contrary to the standards accepted by the community.
Members and others defined in HM2.3 will not engage in bullying or harassing or unacceptable behaviours towards other members, staff, volunteers or contractors or disorderly conduct.
- Bullying is defined as repeated inappropriate behaviour direct or indirect, whether verbal, gesture, physical or otherwise, conducted by one person or persons against another person or persons.
This includes, but is not limited to:
Cyber bullying – placing an offensive or hurtful public message, image or statement on a social network site or other public forum where that message, image or statement can be viewed and/or repeated by other people will be regarded as bullying behaviour.
 - Unacceptable behaviour is defined as any behaviour that a reasonable person, having regard for the circumstances, would see as victimising, humiliating, undermining or threatening.
 - Disorderly conduct is defined as disturbing the peace or endangering the morals, health or safety of others. (07/15)
- 2.3 Members shall be responsible for any and all actions by themselves, their family members or guests when attending sanctioned events and their interactions with other members at all times.
This includes but is not limited to:
- Littering
 - Damage
 - Unacceptable behaviour
 - Bullying
- 2.4 A member shall not indulge in false or misleading advertising relating to the conformation, characteristics or performance of that member's dog.
- 2.5 A member shall not misrepresent nor malign the conformation, characteristics or performance of another member's dog.
- 2.6 A member shall at all times and in all forums, including at DogsWest approved events, in dealings in wider forums including chat lists on the internet and in all other communications, conduct themselves in a manner respectful of the reputation of the ANKC and DogsWest members, judges, staff and officials. 08/11
- 2.7 An exhibitor is not to contact a judge after the announcement of that judge's appointment by any means that may be interpreted as promoting that exhibitor or exhibitor's exhibits. This includes social networking sites, email,

and all electronic forms of communication as well as traditional forms of communication. Should a judge receive such an approach, they are required to make a report to the appropriate member body and disciplinary action may be taken against the exhibitor. 08/11

- 2.8 Members shall constantly strive to improve their knowledge of their chosen breed or breeds, and their knowledge of the requirements for the care, welfare and betterment of dogs.
- 2.9 Members shall ensure that all dogs under their control are properly controlled, housed, fed, watered, exercised and receive veterinary care as and when required. A member shall not knowingly allow any dogs under their care to roam at large.
- 2.10 A member shall permit any person authorised in writing by the Administrative Officer, following a resolution of the Governing Council, to enter and inspect any premises owned or occupied by the member for the purpose of investigating compliance with HM2.9 of this Code.
2.10.1 During the conduct of the inspection the member will permit the authorised person to record any necessary details by tape, video or photographs.
2.10.2 Failure to permit the inspection of the premises without reasonable cause shall result in suspension of the member's privileges until that inspection has taken place. 04/17
- 2.11 The registered owner of a dog shall remain ultimately responsible for said dog, including if left in the care of another person.
- 2.12 A member shall take all appropriate lawful measures to assist a dog in distress.
- 2.13 A member shall positively enhance the reputation of dog breeders and owners by ensuring that dogs owned by the member are not a danger or nuisance to the community.
When the dog is away from home a member shall ensure that it is kept on a leash and/or effective control at all times.
- 2.14 A member shall not participate in nor support any activity that involves cruelty or damage to animals, excluding legal hunting activities.
- 2.15 A member shall not surrender dogs owned, in the care of or bred by the member to a pound or animal refuge. Breed Rescue Clubs run by ANKC Ltd members are exempt (04/20)

BREEDING

- 2.16 A member shall breed primarily for the purpose of improving the quality and / or working ability of the breed in accordance with the breed standard, and not specifically for the pet or commercial market. A member retains the right of free trade, to advertise directly and sell dogs not kept for line maintenance purposes by that member.
- 2.17 A member shall not breed with a bitch unless the bitch has reached adequate maturity for that breed as determined by the member's Member Body. The minimum breeding age for bitches across all breeds is twelve (12) months at the time of mating. Except in extenuating circumstances or with the approval of Governing Council prior to the mating, a member shall not breed from any bitch causing it to be mated before it is twelve months of age. 08/14
- 2.18 A member shall not breed a bitch causing it to whelp
- **more than twice in any eighteen month period** without the prior approval of the member's Member Body. (07/16)
- 2.19 Number of Litters
- 2.19.1 A member shall not breed a bitch causing it to whelp more than five (5) times.



- 2.19.2 It is the responsibility of the current registered owner to verify the number of litters a bitch may have had prior to their ownership of said bitch.
- 2.19.3 Extenuating circumstances
- 2.19.3.1 A member may apply to Dogs West for permission for a sixth (6th) litter.
The application is to include:
- a veterinary certification of fitness for further breeding issued in the last 30 days
- the positive identification of the bitch – microchip
- reasons for the need for a sixth litter
- 2.19.3.2 The member must have obtained written permission for the sixth (6th) litter PRIOR to mating the bitch
- 2.19.3.3 The permission is valid for a period of six months – after this permission must be re-applied for.
- 2.19.3.4 Under no circumstances will the registration of a seventh (7) litter be permitted. **(04/17)**
- 2.20 Maximum Breeding Age
- 2.20.1 A member shall not mate a bitch over the age of seven (7) years.
Note: after the bitch's seventh birthday. **(07/18)**
- 2.20.2 It is the responsibility of the current registered owner to verify the number of litters a bitch may have had prior to their ownership of said bitch.
- 2.20.3 Extenuating Circumstances
- 2.20.3.1 A member may apply to Dogs West for permission to mate a bitch over seven years of age. The application is to include:
· a veterinary certification of fitness for further breeding issued in the last 30 days
· the positive identification of the bitch – microchip
· reasons for the need for a litter from a bitch of this age
- 2.20.3.2 The member must have obtained written permission PRIOR to mating the bitch
- 2.20.3.3 The permission is valid for a period of six months – after this permission must be re-applied for.
- 2.20.3.4 Under no circumstances will permission for a further litter be granted. **(04/17)**
- 2.21 First generation (father/daughter, mother/son, brother/sister) matings are not permitted. ANKC Ltd Member Bodies will not register the progeny of father/daughter, mother/son, brother/sister matings on the Main Register unless application was made to the Member Body and approval was given prior to the mating on the basis of health or genetic reasons to the benefit of the breed.
Any breach of this regulation will constitute an offence by the member(s) who are the owners of the sire and the dam of the litter.
The progeny resulting from such a breach will be registered on the Limited Register and endorsed 'never to be upgraded' and any further penalties as may be determined by the member's Member Body. Refer ANKC Part 6 – 8.4 **(Added 10/10, Amended EAP 12/14)**
- 2.22 A member shall not permit any of that members' ANKC Registered dogs, without prior approval from the Association, to be used in any mating which would result in a litter being ineligible for registration on the ANKC Register. This includes
- 2.22.1 To a dog of a different breed
- 2.22.2 To a cross bred dog
- 2.22.3 to a non ANKC registered dog of the same breed or
- 2.22.4 to a dog not on the ANKC Main Register
- 2.22.5 a mating not in compliance with R2.1. 02/21
- 2.23 Breaches of Regulations 2.18, 2.19, 2.20, 2.21 and 2.22 are considered to be a serious breach of the Code of Ethics. For that reason, offences in relation to each of the separate regulations will be considered cumulatively in applying penalties to the Registered Breeder/Member.
Any puppies not registered on the Main Register are to be registered on the Limited Register with the endorsement 'Not to be upgraded to Main register'. **08/11, 04/13**
- 2.24 A member shall take responsible action to reduce the incidence of hereditary diseases in accordance with the ANKC Code of Practice for Hereditary Diseases.
- 2.25 A member shall not, within Australia, sell or otherwise transfer from that member's care any puppy under eight [8] weeks of age without the approval of the member's Member Body.
Puppies are to be microchipped and vaccinated prior to leaving the Member's care.
- 2.26 A member shall not export a puppy under the age of eleven [11] weeks, or such greater age permitted under the livestock import requirements of the country to which the puppy is being exported.
- 2.27 A member shall not knowingly sell a dog to any person residing in an overseas country known to be involved in the utilisation of dogs for the meat trade without first satisfying the member's Member Body that the purchaser is a member of an ANKC recognised canine controlling body in the overseas country. The member and purchaser must further acknowledge in writing to the member's Member Body that the intention of the sale is for the improvement of the quality of that breed in the overseas country, and not for any other purpose.
- 2.28 A member shall ensure that persons acquiring dogs from that member understand the requirements for the care, welfare and responsible ownership of the dog, and that they have the time and facilities, e.g. adequate fences, sufficient room and proper shelter, to fulfil their responsibilities.
- 2.29 A breeder shall be expected to maintain reasonable contact with the purchasers of dogs from that breeder and to offer continued advice and reasonable assistance.
- 2.30 A member **must** register all puppies bred by that member that are living at the date of registration. Such registration must include all living puppies from the litter on the one litter registration application form and must be applied for within six [6] months of the date of whelping.
- 2.31 A member shall provide to all recipients of dogs sold or otherwise disposed of by that member, written details of:
- 2.31.1 The breed characteristics;
- 2.31.2 Current Vaccination certificate signed by a Veterinary Surgeon evidencing that the dog has been immunised against Canine Distemper, Hepatitis and Parvo Virus
- 2.31.3 Microchip number verification – transfer is the responsibility of the vendor in accordance with R19.
- 2.31.4 Responsible dog ownership information; and
- 2.31.5 All documentation required by the member's Member Body, including
- 2.31.5.1 a written receipt clearly stating whether the dog was sold with or without a Certificate of Registration (Main or Limited) - "with or without papers" shall mean the Certificate of Registration
- 2.31.5.2 any other conditions of sale and/or agreements **(04/17)**
- 2.32 A member shall not incorrectly describe nor knowingly misrepresent the characteristics of a breed.
- 2.33 A member shall ensure that all dogs sold or disposed of by that member are in the best possible state of health. Where a dog with a health issue or disability is disposed of the member must obtain from the recipient written and signed acknowledgement of the condition of the dog.
- 2.34 A member shall not:
- 2.34.1 Sell or dispose of a dog to a commercial pet wholesaler or retail pet shop. Nor shall a member's dog/s be advertised, displayed or sold on commission by a commercial dog wholesaler or retail pet dealer. **[07/15]**
- 2.34.2 Allow a dog owned by that member to be given as a prize or donation or to be auctioned.
- GENERAL**
- 2.35 A member who provides or makes available a dog for use in a film, advertisement, promotion, or any media or public display must ensure that:
- 2.35.1 The dog is portrayed in a manner consistent with its breed characteristics and temperament as described in the Standard for that breed; and
- 2.35.2 The dog is presented in a manner that is unlikely to create a negative reaction to dogs generally or that breed in particular and that if there is any likelihood of a negative impression, this is at the same time corrected through the development of a story line that presents the dog or breed in a balanced manner.
- 2.36 A member shall oppose all activities which involve cruelty to dogs or in which dogs inflict damage on other dogs or other animals excluding the hunting of vermin.
- 2.37 A breeder must include their ANKC Ltd Member Body Membership Number in any advertisement for puppies whatever the media and all members must include the following wording in their advertisements:
"Please contact Dogs West on email: k9@dogswest.com to verify my membership."
- 2.38 A member shall not use or cause to be displayed, in any form or in any media, their Dogs West membership number in relation to any progeny, real or planned, from a dog not on the ANKC MAIN register. **(06/20)**
- 2.39 A member shall not declare, make or infer any relationship, in any form or in any media, between their membership of The Association, The Association and any dog not eligible for entry onto an ANKC register. **(06/20)**
